Purpose

This assessment sheet helps homeowners and property managers perform a safe, structured inspection after severe weather.

It provides a step-by-step checklist for documenting visible and hidden issues so every action supports a smooth recovery.

I. Initial Safety Check – Before Entering

- ☐ Wait for official clearance if flooding, downed power lines, or structural damage is visible.
- ☐ Do not enter basements or crawlspaces until electrical systems are confirmed safe.
- ☐ Wear closed-toe shoes, gloves, and protective gear if debris or standing water is present.
- ☐ Photograph exterior conditions from a safe distance before cleanup begins.

II. Exterior Inspection – Ground-Level and Roofline

Area	What to Look For	Notes / Photos
Roof	Missing shingles, sagging areas, or exposed underlayment	
Gutters & Downspouts	Detachment, blockages, improper drainage	
Siding & Trim	Impact damage, cracks, or water staining	
Windows & Doors	Broken glass, warped frames, failed seals	
Foundation & Grading	Pooling water, new cracks, soil erosion

III. Interior Inspection – Walls, Ceilings, and Floors

Area	What to Look For	Notes / Photos
Ceilings	Water rings, sagging drywall, discoloration	
Walls	Bubbling paint, damp patches, odor of mildew	
Floors	Warped wood, lifted edges, soft spots in carpet	
Windowsills & Trim	Moisture, condensation, visible mold	
Attic or Crawlspaces	Wet insulation, condensation, pest intrusion	
<input type="checkbox"/> Use a flashlight to check corners and hidden cavities.		
<input type="checkbox"/> Mark areas that feel soft or damp for moisture testing.		

IV. Utility and Systems Review

- ☐ Power: Inspect breaker panel for corrosion or odor. Do not reset breakers until inspected.
- ☐ Plumbing: Check visible lines and fixtures for leaks.
- ☐ HVAC: Replace filters; note unusual noise or odor.
- ☐ Appliances: Unplug and inspect before use if exposed to moisture.
- ☐ Smoke and CO Detectors: Test batteries and confirm operation.
