## R – Ready the Home

Goal: Strengthen your property before the next storm or emergency.

- ☐ Inspect roof, gutters, and drainage twice per year (spring and fall).
- ☐ Confirm downspouts discharge 5 ft or more from the foundation.
- ☐ Label main shutoffs for water, gas, and electricity.
- ☐ Test sump pump and backup power before storm season.
- ☐ Review insurance coverage and store policies safely (digital + waterproof print).
- ☐ Save key contacts:
  - Restore Now 24/7 Dispatch: 971-406-2926
  - Insurance provider
  - Utilities
  - Property manager

## A – Act Fast

Goal: Protect people first, then stabilize the situation safely.

- ☐ Ensure everyone is safe; avoid electrical and structural hazards.
- ☐ Shut off utilities only if safe.
- ☐ Photograph visible damage before moving items.
- ☐ Do not discard materials until reviewed by professionals.
- ☐ Call Restore Now 24/7 immediately to coordinate certified response.

## P – Protect and Communicate

Goal: Keep everyone informed and reduce confusion.

Situation	What to Do
Active leak or burst pipe	Call plumber, then RN24/7, then insurance provider
Smoke or soot odor	Call RN24/7 before running HVAC
Visible mold	Call RN24/7 for testing and containment
Biohazard or trauma	Call RN24/7, then insurance provider
Major property loss	Contact RN24/7 and your insurance company at the same time. Do not wait for adjuster assignment.

<input type="checkbox"/> Use photos and short notes instead of long explanations.	

## I – Initiate Certified Response

Goal: Begin controlled restoration and documentation.

- ☐ Request moisture mapping and air-quality testing before reconstruction.
- ☐ Replace HVAC filters and inspect electrical systems before restart.
- ☐ Save all invoices, reports, and claim correspondence in one folder.

## D – Debrief and Strengthen

Goal: Turn every event into a plan for prevention.

- ☐ Review what worked and update your checklist.
- ☐ Schedule follow-up inspections on roof, drainage, and plumbing.
- ☐ Replenish your emergency kit and update contact list quarterly.
